We motivate and encourage our students to try harder and build their self-concept in the process. We are friendly and positive and make an effort to get to know each student individually.

Our facility has three large studio rooms so that the dancers will have plenty of room to execute techniques they have learned. For your convenience there is a small shop where dance clothes and shoes may be purchased.

The studio is centrally located to Milford, North Webster, Leesburg, Warsaw, Ligonier, Goshen and New Paris on 300 East in Syracuse.

POLICIES

There is a registration fee of **\$25.00 per class**. This fee is nonrefundable and nontransferable but will be applied toward dance costumes if the student dances for the entire year.

All students should attend each lesson and be properly dressed. Any student who is not dressed properly may not be permitted to dance with the class.

Students may not be permitted to participate in class if tuition payments are past due.

A parent or guardian must notify the dance school if the student is unable to attend a class. We also request that a parent or guardian remain in the building during classes for students 8 years old and younger.

Dance classes may not be held due to inclement weather. Please watch WSBT-TV, check WSBT.com, check the dance school website at StewartDanceSchool.com or call the dance school after 3:30 PM if conditions are questionable.

You are charged for all classes whether attended or not. Make-up classes will be provided only if a student has missed numerous classes and is behind other students.

- Yearly payments are due by September 7, 2012.
- Bi-Yearly payments are due by September 7, 2012, and January 7, 2013.
- Monthly payments are due the 5th of each month, September through May.
- A late fee of \$5.00 will be applied on unpaid balances after the 9th of each month.
- Monthly statements are mailed only if the account is past due or when costume balances have been applied.
- A \$30.00 fee will be charged for each returned check and future payments must be cash, credit card or money order.
- To withdraw from classes, the official signed withdrawal form must be received at the dance school 30 days prior to the final class.
- There are no refunds for any tuition or costume fees paid.
- Payments may be mailed or dropped off at the dance studio. VISA, MasterCard and Discover accepted.

DRESS CODE

All female students are required to wear a **solid** black leotard for all classes (**no stripes or decals**). Please, **no** prints, stripes, patterns or floral prints. No two-piece dancewear is acceptable. Tights should be worn and may be black, light pink, white or tan. No underwear is permitted under dance attire. Ballet students may wear a sheer black ballet skirt. Hip hop students may wear dance pants and a t-shirt over the leotard.

Male students are required to wear **solid** black shirts, **solid** black dance pants or shorts and black dance shoes.

Sweatshirts, sweatpants, headscarves and other apparel may not be worn during any class.

Required dance shoes include:

Ballet—pink ballet shoes

Jazz—tan jazz oxfords

Tap (pre school—3rd grade)—tan buckle tap shoes

Tap (4th—adult)—tan jazz tap shoes

Hip Hop Bop & Jam—tan jazz oxfords

Hip Hop—black dance sneakers

Dancers are strongly encouraged to wear their hair in a low ballet bun for all dance classes.

DANCE PRODUCTION

Our annual dance production will be held three (3) times on June 14, 15 and 16, at the Warsaw High School Performing Arts Center. Some classes will be asked to dance in more than one performance, but most classes will perform in one show. Costumes for the dance production will be chosen and pictures will be made available in January. The costumes will range in price from \$40.00 to \$70.00. The costume balance due will be posted to accounts and a statement mailed in December. The balance of the costume fee will be due by January 5, 2013.

During the week of the dance productions, all students will be required to attend a technical rehearsal on Monday, June 10, 2013, and each dress rehearsal for every show in which they perform.

Rehearsals are mandatory to participate in the dance production.

Any student who misses five or more lessons after January 1, 2013, may not be permitted to perform in the dance production.

We would like for all students to participate in the dance production for the theatrical experience of their dance education; however, it is strictly optional.
